general information

This stool is made of solid Dimb wood. Dimb wood is a durable hardwood from Senegal. Please keep in mind that solid wooden objects always have the tendency to work and crack. This gives charm and character to the wooden object.
This stool is suitable for indoor and outdoor use. When using the stool outdoors, the color of the wood will slowly turn grey.

Each piece has been created with passion and the greatest attention to detail. Minor variations in colour and size may have occurred during the manufacturing process. We hope that you also appreciate the craftsmanship that makes your pols potten original unique.

care instructions

- Clean by wiping with a damp cloth and immediately wipe dry with a soft dry cloth.
- Avoid contact with abrasive, alcohol and solvent based substances or cleaning agents, they can damage the surface.
- The use of furniture polish or sprays is neither necessary nor recommended.
- Remove liquid spills immediately with an absorbent cloth to prevent staining.
- To prevent stains the use of coasters is recommended.
- Do not strike with hard or sharp items.
To extend the product life and appearance when using outdoors, it is advisable to store the furniture in a cool dry place over winter and during periods of wet seasons. Ensure that the furniture is clean and completely dry before putting it into storage. Do not enclose the furniture in a plastic or other non permeable material as this promotes the growth of mildew and mould. Cover it with a dust sheet or furniture cover allowing the air to circulate around it.

safety note

- Always completely lift the furniture in an upright position when moving it. Handle and move with care as improper handling may cause material damage and personal injury.
- Heavy/larger furniture pieces should be moved by two persons.
- Ensure the furniture is always placed level on its legs.
- Do not stand, climb or jump on the furniture.
- Please keep these instructions for future reference.
